

Frequently Asked Questions about Clean Out Day at Forest Hills

Q: Do I have to pay anything to participate in the Forest Hills clean out day?

A: No, if you are a resident of Forest Hills, this is a service to you provided by the City of Forest Hills and is managed by EarthSavers Recycling.

Q: Can I come to recycle that day if I am not a Forest Hills resident?

A: You can come to visit, but not to recycle! This event is strictly for residents of Forest Hills. If you are seeking regular residential recycling services from EarthSavers, please click [here](#). If you are seeking a place to responsibly and legally dispose of goods that are regulated by the county (i.e., paint) please see the county website

Q: I am a Forest Hills resident and I'm not sure what I can bring. Do you have a list?

Q: If I don't make it to City Hall between 8:30am-12:30pm, can I just leave my items at the end of my driveway?

A: This is an on-site at City Hall event only. Items left at the end of your driveway are subject to sanctions per city code.
