



## Construction Activity Policy

Municipal Ordinance 2014-215 states that construction activity is limited to following hours:

**7am-6pm Monday through Friday**

**8am-5pm Saturday**

**No Sundays or Holidays**

Construction is defined as the erection (including excavation), demolition, alteration or repair of any building in any area or the construction or repair of driveways or other hardscapes.

The City of Forest Hills is strongly committed to enforcing these regulations. Violation of these regulations will result in the following consequences.

- *First offense:* A warning call: The City will call the contractor on record with the permit and discuss the regulations as stated.
- *Second offense:* The City will issue a stop work order for a day.
- *Third Offense:* The City will issue a stop work order for a week (7 days) and fine the contractor.
- *Offenses after the third offense* will result in a possible injunction to stop work indefinitely, citation to Court, and a possible negative complaint to the Better Business Bureau.

Violations may be reported in the following ways:

- A time-stamped photo of construction
- A report on See Click Fix with a photo stating the time when the picture was taken
- A photo with a signed statement of when it was taken
- Personal experience documented by the City Manager or an assigned designee

Residents may call on suspicion of construction and the City Manager will follow up with the complaint.
